

# Baby PDA



## Can babies be PDA?

PDA is a life-long neurological difference (brain-type) so it's always present at birth, though the signs might be subtle

## Is babyhood PDA caused by trauma?

PDA is not caused by trauma. PDA traits, such as anxiety, are similar to CPTSD (complex post traumatic stress disorder) but the PDA profile is genetic and even PDA babies raised in nurturing, trauma-free environments exhibit CPTSD-like traits

## Does PDA show up before birth?

Many parents identify signs of PDA before their children were born. Examples are holding tight in the womb to delay birth or managing to break the waters and flying out weeks ahead of their due date

## Are PDA babies passive?

Traditional descriptions of PDA talk of passive early years. The reality seems to be that, while some PDA babies are passive, others display the roller coaster emotions of older PDA kids

## What PDA traits can babies show?

PDA babies can display all PDA traits. Examples are avoiding milestones and yanking heads to command attention



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
